Preamble

The UM6P sustainable development approach will be implemented in line with the STARS Sustainability Tracking, Assessment & Rating SystemTM. This framework allows us to pilot, measure and guide our actions on sustainable development through performance indicators and objectives.

The STARS framework has been developed to help universities measure and guide their actions in areas of sustainable development, as part of their education and research mission. Over 900 universities around the world are participating in this international accreditation.

The STARS system provides a set of criteria and points for classifying universities in their sustainable development positioning.

STARS covers four headings, namely the academic dimension, the engagement dimension, the operational dimension of the institutions, besides the planning and administration dimension.
